The simulation teaches, in a very hands-on way, the positive impact of a repeatable process framework for continuous improvement on quality and performance of the briefing process.

In the "Briefing the Minister" simulation, participants take roles in a fictitious (but close to heart) agency to deliver accurate Ministerial briefings in time and to the Minister's satisfaction.

Complexity and Innovation

We will introduce the concepts complexity, Action Focussed Innovation and performance improvement in the context of the public sector.

We will then discuss the impact of complexity on organisations and how they can respond.

Afternoon Sessions
